



How to Buy a *Swift* Ticket

Each *Swift* station has two ticket vending machines. All passengers must have a valid *Swift* ticket, a valid flash pass (e.g., EdPass) or pay with their ORCA card prior to boarding *Swift*.

Four Easy Steps to Purchase Your Ticket:

1. Press the green button to start.
2. Select your fare type.
3. Insert payment.
4. Take your ticket.

Know Your Fare:

Before you start, know which fare you are paying and have your money ready, just like onboard a bus.

Adult (19-64) ... \$1.50
 Youth (6-18) ... \$1.00
 Reduced Fare ... 50¢
 ORCA Upgrade ... 25¢
 ORCA Upgrade ... 75¢



STEP 1. Press the green button to start.



STEP 2. Select your fare type.

The machine is set for Adult fare, so if you're paying an adult fare go to the next step.

If you wish to pay a reduced or youth fare, or to purchase an ORCA upgrade ticket, press the yellow button until you have selected the proper fare type.



If you normally ride Everett Transit and have a 75¢ pass on your ORCA card, you may need to purchase an ORCA upgrade ticket for correct *Swift* fare. To avoid this step, the best solution is to put E-purse value on your ORCA card.

STEP 3. Insert payment.

Please use exact change. The machine only takes \$1 bills and U.S. coins, no pennies. The machine does not give change. You can insert two \$1 bills but you will not receive change.



You may also use VISA or MasterCard credit or debit cards to purchase a ticket. Insert your card in the slot near the blue “credit card” label and remove the card when prompted. Then press the light blue button to start the transaction.

Press the red cancel button if you’ve made a mistake. However, if your payment has gone through you will not get a refund. Only coins will be returned.



If you are choosing a fare type other than Adult, be sure to make your payment quickly as the machine resets back to Adult in about 30 seconds.

STEP 4. Take your ticket.

When the machine has processed your payment, a ticket will drop into the ticket slot. Lift the window and remove your ticket.

Tickets are valid for one ride on *Swift* and are time-stamped to expire in one hour. Please retain your ticket and show it to a *Swift* Ambassador if asked for proof of payment.
